Pre-Conference Summer School

The Summer Academic Research Programme with Two Cambridge Professors (The Pre-Conference Summer School) is the designated training programme for the SDG & AI+ Academic Conferences 2026 administrated by UniHive and held at Clare Hall and Murray Edwards College, University of Cambridge.

The Programme will provide training and networking opportunities for students and early career researchers in areas related to the themes of the conferences. Under the guidance of two Cambridge professors, participants will explore cutting-edge topics within their disciplines, receive systematic training for their relevant academic skills, and lay foundation for developing their academic career further.

Multiple Recognitions

Participants will receive a certificate of attendance issued by the hosting college of University of Cambridge. Students who achieved top grades in the programme will receive recommendation letter(s) from the teaching professors(s), thereby providing strong support for their future academic progression.

Attend the Academic Conference

After completing the Programme, the participants will present their academic poster at the SDG or AI+ conference. They will enjoy the full benefit of joining the conference, and further develop their insights in relevant subject through the academic exchange with scholars from around the world.

Application Requirements

1. Full-time undergraduate and postgraduate students aged 18 or above
2. **General Grade** - 85% or equivalent
*transcript submission required; minor short of grade can be evaluated on individual basis
3. Currently studying relevant subjects
4. **Proof of English** - equivalent to IELTS band 5.5 etc.
*any proof of your English level
